# Meeting Minutes

#### June 25, 2016

Meeting held at the Isle Casino in Bettendorf. The meeting was called to order at 11:05 am by President Gary Knutson with 11 members in attendance. Present were Vice President Robert Thompson, Secretary Robert Stebbins, and Treasurer Lynn Clark.

Minutes of the May meeting were read by Robert Stebbins. Gary Knutson noted the date of the last
meeting should be changed from March 21st to May 21st. Gary Gleason made a motion to accept the
minutes with the change in date, with a second by John Montgomery. The motion passed unanimously.
 Treasurer's report: Club is solvent.

Ken Mizaur made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, with a second by Vickie Stoltenberg. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Old Business

- Gary Gleason gave an update on the status of planning for the 2016 Quad States.
  - ⇒ Photographer:
    - For \$100, the photographer will take pictures of all cars at the show. These pictures will be organized by judging class and loaded onto a CD. A DVD of all show cars, or printed photographs of specific cars, will be available for purchase from the photographer.
    - \* Gary Gleason and/or Jerry Dykes will likely be presenting the trophies at the awards banquet. Lynn Clark will be reading of the class winners.
    - \* We will possibly need two different slide shows; one with all the show cars to run in the background during the banquet meal, and another with only the award winning cars to be used during the trophy presentation.
    - \* The photographer may dedicate one month of his annual Oldsmobile calendar to our Quad States show.

#### $\Rightarrow$ Security:

- Gary needs to check with Leah to find out how much security is offered by the casino, and then we will fill the gaps
- \* The Nova Club has volunteered to help us with security, therefore, we probably won't need any OCI members to volunteer.
- \* Leah joined our meeting and said the casino has security cameras outside and a security vehicle that makes one lap around the parking lot approximately every hour. She said the Nova Club hired Per Mar Security to guard their cars overnight.

#### ⇒ Rooms:

\* Close to 150 room nights have been booked.

#### ⇒ Golf carts:

\* Lynn Clark said the deposit check for the golf carts will go out this week.

#### ⇒ Miscellaneous:

- \* We are borrowing radios from Steve Duffy for no charge.
- \* A sample lanyard and nametag for show attendees was passed around.
- \* Gary will be contacting Fusick about free windshield cards.
- \* A brief discussion was held about having a DJ play music outside on the show field. It was decided to have no music during the show.


#### ⇒ Trophies and judging:

- Lynn Clark brought up a discussion about award designation on the trophies.
  - The big trophy plaques will be used for "best of class" only.
  - ♦ The small plaques will be designated "class award" and could possibly be given to two cars per class, depending on the number of entries in each class.
  - This would result in a total of three trophies per class.
- Lynn stated show only cars will be mixed in the judged cars on the show field.
- \* Special show awards will include a president's choice and the casino's choice.

- ⇒ Gary will be sending copies of the spreadsheet of registrations to the OCI board.
- ⇒ Robert Stebbins will include a reminder in next the newsletter about how OCI members need to order their Quad States t-shirts:
  - \* T-shirts ordered on the registration form are full price and will be blue in color.
  - \* T-shirts ordered through Connie Mizaur are sold at a discounted price to Club members and will be yellow in color.

#### New Business

Robert Stebbins brought a sample of a possible new design for Club nametags. The sample includes the latest Club logo design that is currently used on the front page of the newsletter and our Club jackets. The member information on the proposed new nametag is similar to that of the past nametags. Cyclone Awards & Engraving in Ames produced the sample. They can produce the nametags with the traditional pin or clip backs for \$6.00 each, or a magnetic back for \$8.00 each. Vickie Stoltenberg made a motion to order new nametags with magnetic backs, with a second by Ken Mizaur. The motion passed. Order forms will be available in the next newsletter
